Students should note the following guiding principles for selection of subject option:

1. History and Geography are **not** be offered together, e.g. SS+Elective History and Full Geography cannot be taken together.
2. The same Humanities subject cannot be offered as both the elective Humanities and Full Humanities, e.g. elective Geography and Full Geography cannot be taken together.
3. Students in the Express course **must** make selections for the 6-, 7- and 8-subjects options while students in the Normal (Academic) course **must** make selections for the 6- and 7-subjects options.
4. Allocation of subjects will be based on (i) merit, (ii) choice and (iii) resources.
5. Music and Drama are for selected students who pass the qualifying test only

Update Choices and Subject Preferences

Step 1: Rank your preference for 6, 7 or 8 subjects.
Choose carefully and consider:

- The number of subjects you can confidently cope with.
- The curriculum load at the Upper Secondary level is more demanding than at the Lower Secondary level.

Step 2: Rank your preference for the 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th subjects.
(See next page on Ranking of Preference for Other Subjects')

Mandatory Subjects of the Option

Order of Preference for Other Subjects (Do not enter the same subject more than once)

For Rank #1, do not select the same Humanities subject for both elective and Full Humanities. For example:

- SS+HIST & HIST
- SS+GEOG & GEOG
- SS+LIT & LIT

History and Geography cannot be offered in the same sitting.

STEPS

- Enter your Choice for each Option, i.e. choice 1, 2, 3 or 4 (see step 1 in the diagram)
- For Other Subjects, i.e. the 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th subject, rank all the subjects in each group, where 1 indicates your first choice (see step 2 in the diagram)
- Click on the Submit button

Note

You may change your choices and rank order of the subjects anytime before the closing date. Where there is more than one submission, only the last submission will be considered.

Which Subjects to Choose

****Very important - Your first choice for each section should be a subject that:**

1. You enjoy studying and are interested to deepen your knowledge of.
2. Is relevant to what you would like to pursue after secondary school (refer to Student Journal Pg 49-60).
3. You have done relatively well in for the Sec 2 Mid-Year Examination (recall your Sec 1 experience for modular subjects).

You are advised to follow the sequence below when indicating your choices:

For Express Students

1. For 6-subjects option
 - i. 5th subject - Decide which elective Humanities to take with Social Studies. If you have chosen Full Literature, you should not choose Social Studies, Literature.
 - ii. 6th subject - Choose between Additional Math / Art / Drama / Literature / Principals of Accounts. This should be your strongest subject where a corresponding Lower Secondary subject is available.
2. For 7-subjects option (E07A)
 - i. 6th subject - Decide which Full Humanities to take. This should be your strongest Humanities subject.
 - ii. 5th subject - Decide which elective Humanities to take with Social Studies. The 1st choice subject for your elective Humanities cannot be the same as your Full Humanities choice. History and Geography (one Full Humanities and one elective) cannot be taken together.
 - iii. 7th subject - Choose between Art / Drama / Music / Principals of Accounts. Choose the subject you are strongest in from among these options, where a corresponding Lower Secondary subject is available.
3. For 7-subjects option (E07B)
 - i. 6th subject - Decide which elective Humanities to take with Social Studies. The 1st choice subject for your elective Humanities cannot be the same as your Full Humanities choice. History and Geography (one Full Humanities and one elective) cannot be taken together.
 - ii. 7th subject - Choose between Biology / Physics.
4. For 8-subjects option
 - i. 6th subject - Decide which elective Humanities to take with Social Studies. The 1st choice subject for your elective Humanities cannot be the same as your Full Humanities choice, if any. History and Geography (one full Humanities and one elective) cannot be taken together.
 - ii. 7th subject – Decide between Biology and Physics (this should be the science which you are most inclined towards).
 - iii. 8th subject – Decide whether to take Art / Drama / Full Humanities / Music / 3rd Science. Based on your results, are you more inclined to the Humanities or Maths and Science? If you choose Full Humanities, this should be your strongest Humanities subject. If you choose a 3rd Science, this should not be the same subject as the previous section.
5. Remarks Box - Possible options
 - Art / Drama / Music as an additional subject (6+1) or (7+1)

For Normal (Academic) Students

1. For 6-subjects option
 - i. 5th subject - Decide whether to take elective Geography or elective Literature with Social Studies.
 - ii. 6th subject - Choose between Art / Food & Nutrition / Geography / Literature / Principals of Accounts. This should be your strongest subject where a corresponding Lower Secondary subject is available.
2. For 7-subjects option
 - i. 5th subject - Decide whether to take elective Geography or elective Literature with Social Studies.
 - ii. 6th subject - Choose between Art / Food & Nutrition / Geography / Literature / Principals of Accounts. This should be your strongest subject where a corresponding Lower Secondary subject is available.
 - iii. 7th subject - Choose between Additional Math / Drama / Music.
